Looking at Indiana's 2017 performance, the state continues to deliver top marks in the categories of *Manufacturing*, *Logistics*, *Tax Climate*, and *Global Reach*.

Grades for *Worker Benefit Costs* improved from "C+" to "B" due to decline in health premiums and worker's compensation rates relative to other states. Indiana was one of the Top 5 states that experienced a drop in health insurance premiums between 2014 and 2015, which could be due to expansion of Healthy Indiana Plan (HIP) 2.0 in 2015. The HIP 2.0 enrolled around 400,000 Indiana residents aged 19 to 64 with family income at or below 138 percent of the FPL. The private insurance providers in Indiana such as Anthem and MDwise also offer HIP 2.0 plans to choose from. The large number of enrollment would have helped insurers to get better negotiated rates with hospitals/physicians, thereby reducing the premiums of employer/employee. The actual estimate of HIP 2.0 on premiums is left for future research.

Expected Fiscal Liability Gap improved slightly from "C+" in 2016 to "B-" in 2017 because of relative changes in ranking for other states.

The *Productivity and Innovation* category saw a marginal decrease from 2016's "B+" to 2017's "B" due to a relative decline in manufacturing value-added growth.
